Result	<p>Latvijas Banka's Regulation No 132 "Regulation for Compiling the Monthly Financial Position Report of Monetary Financial Institutions" of 16 May 2014 is amended to implement the recast Regulation (EU) No 1071/2013 of the European Central Bank of 24 September 2013 concerning the balance sheet of the monetary financial institutions sector (ECB/2013/33), thus at the EU level ensuring harmonised statistical data for the purposes of monetary and financial analysis.</p> <p>Moreover, the related Latvijas Banka's regulations may be amended to implement the change in the scope of the MFI definition caused by the amendments to Regulation (EU) No 575/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 June 2013 whereby investment firms whose consolidated assets equal 30 billion euros or exceed the said amount are credit institutions.
