	Payment statistics is obtained in a more detailed breakdown (e.g., by payment initiation channel, payment authentication method and payment instrument scheme) and on the new types of payment services and innovative payment opportunities (e.g., payment initiation services, mobile payment solutions and contactless payments). The following data are also available: data on instant payments executed via internet banking applications and ATMs or other terminals and mobile payment solutions, and detailed data on card-based payment transactions in breakdown by country and merchant category code.
	The data is mainly used to carry out the supervision and oversight of payment instruments used in Latvia, to analyse fraudulent cases in the field of payments, to improve the coverage and quality of balance of payments statistics, and to meet the new requirements of Regulation (EU) No 1409/2013 of the European Central Bank of 28 November 2013 on payments statistics (ECB/2013/43).
	Concurrently, the process of reporting payments statistics data is optimized in Latvia by providing a single point of contact for reporting of such data. Consequently, the reporting agents report data on fraudulent payments to Latvijas Banka, and Latvijas Banka transmits the data that are necessary for supervisory purposes to the FCMC.
